Recently, our shop has expanded it's capacity with three new major fabrication machines and more square footage for our craftsmen.

The Yukon II dimensioning saw allows us to make more advanced and accurate miter cuts with its programmable computer system with touch screen controls. This advanced saw offers 10 programmable cut widths and handles saw blades up to 24 inches.



Fox utilizes two Flow CNC Waterjet Cutters. CNC stands for Computer Numeric Controlled. Our CAD operator team loads projects into our computer system and the waterjet cuts the stone with precision, using a combination of water and abrasives under extremely high pressure. Our waterjet quickly and accurately cuts straight lines and curves in the stone for a perfect cut everytime.





The Intermac Master Stone 2300 is utilized for routing, edging (internal and external), sink cutouts, drain boards, and blade cutting.



The Intermac Master 33 excels at carving, drilling, profiling, tapering, milling, grinding & ageing stone depending on the project. This powerful PC controlled machine accurately cuts jobs quickly and efficiently.



The Brembana is capable of profiling and polishing pieces of any geometric shape.
